Biochemistry & Molecular Biology Master's Scholarship Program

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded to qualifying Master's students after their first semester, beginning in Fall 2013.
- 2. Scholarships are awards that cover half of tuition and fees for the remaining 22 credits, and a total of \$3000 to partially cover supply costs to the lab mentoring the qualifying student.
- 3. To qualify, students must:
 - a. have and maintain at least a GPA of 3.5
 - b. have completed and submitted approved Plan of Work and Research Plan Forms, meaning that that have a research mentor and committee and an approved research plan
 - c. be full time research track (Option 2) students
 - d. not withdraw from any course or receive an incomplete other than the scheduled Y for BMB7890
- 4. Students must maintain these standards each semester to automatically receive the award the following semester.
- 5. Decisions will be made on a case-by case basis by the committee/adviser as to whether the award would be renewed after a leave of absence (without registration and no financial award for one semester) for the semester in which they return.
- 6. The number of scholarships awarded per year will be based on available funds.
